Dues

Please note that seniors **MUST** fulfill all requirements for the NAHS to receive a cord. Refunds are not given to seniors who pay for a graduation cord but do not fulfill requirements by May 1st 2017.

Bylaws that Require Student Agreement

Please Initial for each section if they are clear and you understand and agree to them.	
_____	Section 2. To remain a member in good standing, a member must pay dues and complete 3 service hours in the visual arts each year. One of these hours may be earned during the lunch meetings if you participate in the service activity for that month.
_____	Section 3. Annual dues of \$20 will be collected from each member. The amount charged covers chapter registration fees and other expenses including projects during each meetings.
_____	Section 4. Attendance is required at meetings to maintain membership and privileges. Students may miss a total of two meetings in a year, regardless of the reason.

_____	Section 5. All members must participate in 2 of our projects and one meeting spent on service. All NAHS members are required to attend the Spring Northwest High School Art Show. One service hour may be earned during the lunch NAHS meetings. The other service hours are earned by helping an art teacher at lunch or afterschool.
_____	Section 6. For the NAHS officers, attendance is also required at any executive meetings called outside of the regularly scheduled meetings.
_____	Section 7. To graduate with NAHS honors as a senior and earn the right to wear a cord, pin, or tassel at graduation, a member must remain in good standing until the graduation date. Cords are only given to seniors that have paid for the cord and fulfilled all requirements. There is no refund for graduation cords. If a senior would like to wear a cord at graduation they MUST be a member their senior year as well as at least one other year during 9 th , 10 th , or 11 th grade year.
_____	Section 8. The National Art Honors Society is an honors society and requires its members to have a B average in all art courses. In addition members should also have a B average or above in all regular courses. Members should be a good example to other students in art classes. NAHS members who are disrespectful to any art teacher or other students can be dropped from the NAHS with no refund of any fees.
_____	Section 9. Members must have and maintain a 2.9 cumulative average in all other subjects. This GPA is calculated each semester. If a student falls below this average at interim time, or at the end of first or third quarter, they must attend tutoring at least once a week until the end of the quarter, in the case of an Interim, or for the following quarter, in the case of first and third quarters. In addition, students may not have more than five unexcused absences in any of their classes. Three unexcused tardies equals an unexcused absence.
_____	Section 10. Members should be enrolled in an art class to be a member. Students may remain active during such time when there are no visual arts on their class schedules only with the prior approval of the co-sponsors in extenuating circumstances.
_____	Section 11. In the event of an infraction of rules, a review by the officers and sponsors will be conducted. If the individual in question is an officer, he/she will not participate in the decision-making process. This applies to all community laws as well as school and chapter rules.
